Whole exome sequencing (WES) is a genetic test for patients with multiple or overlapping symptoms that cannot be clearly linked to a single diagnosis.

WES analyzes all coding regions of all nuclear genes currently identified, optimizing the chances of finding the cause of a heritable disease. Reveal Exome has the coverage and features you expect including:

- Coverage of all expert-approved ClinVar pathogenic variants, including those located in intronic or intergenic regions
- Copy number analysis
- Detection of regions of homozygosity
- Whole blood, oral swab and extracted DNA sample types



Testing Options



Each order must be accompanied by a clinical questionnaire (CQ) and clinical consent (CC). Additionally, each sample within the order (3 samples for Trio, 2 samples for Duo, and 1 sample for Proband) must have its own test request form. These documents can be located in the Labcorp Test Menu on Labcorp.com under related documents for the applicable test. Also include a front and back copy of the patient's insurance card. The CQ and CC are not necessary if they were previously provided to Labcorp for a prior authorization in advance of sample collection.
